#### Consider natural light and artificial light

What time of the day are you in the room, the most? This is going to help you decide how saturated your color should be.

STEP (2)

Choose a mood or style:

Elegant, Casual, Romantic, Vibrant, Energetic, Calming
This is going to help you select how intense the color should be.

STEP (3)

#### Select a color family

Here we can pick a color tone:

COOL	WARM	NEUTRAL	
Green Emerald Turquoise Blue Purple Violet	Light Green Yellow Mustard Orange Tangerine Red	Off-white Grey Beige Light Brown	

#### **Pro Tip**

Pick a favorite piece or upholstery from your home or from a magazine. What colors are at play? Are the combination of colors bold, subtle, or monochromatic? Look at this and try to isolate the colors that you find appealing.



#### Go get some samples

Head to the paint store for color chips. With this guide in hand, that wall which is a seemly infinite rainbow of possibilities will not be as overwhelming. Grab a few color strips or chips that are within range of the color that you previously selected above. You will want to take them home to see how the color looks with your lighting. Remember, that the color tone could look different in your home, at different times, throughout the day and evening.



# STEP (5)

#### Test an area (Optional, but highly recommended)

If you're still unsure after selecting the color, you may order a quart or even a smaller sample very affordably. Paint out a small section of wall that is exposed to both full natural light, along with a shadowed area. Feel it out for a day, and you'll know for sure!
